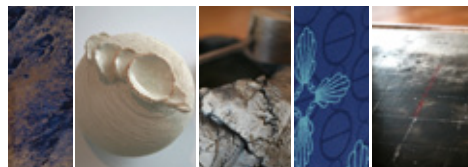

Folding Cosmos is the concept of a touring Japanese tea house which takes inspiration from the Japanese explorer Takeshiro Matsuura's One Mat Room, built as a tranquil setting to reflect upon a life of travels and shared experiences, as well as the traditional Japanese tea ceremony which treasures every meeting as a once in a lifetime experience. The exhibition is a contemporary interpretation of the two themes, created by seven designers, artists and ceramicists. Paula Tew's contribution of textile and book art pieces adds a further element to the exhibition focusing on symbolism within traditional Japanese design motifs.

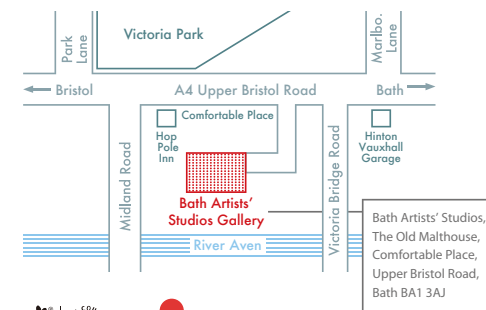
